

Nashville Philatelic Society Premium Auction – Monday, May 25, 2026

All lots to be sold at the Club’s regular live auction on Monday, May 25, 2026.

Bids may be submitted in advance of the live auction by email to davidlperryjr@gmail.com. Bidding is open as soon as the auction email is sent to the Club members generally. Email bids will be accepted until the auction begins, at approximately 6:45 p.m. Central time.

Email bids should indicate the highest price which you are willing to pay for the lot. Lots will be sold to email bidders at one advance over the highest bid at the live auction, or at the starting bid for the lot if there are no other bids.

If there are competing email bids, the lot will open with a bid by the higher email bidder at one advance over the next highest email bidder. If there are two or more email bids with the same maximum bid, the earliest submitted bid shall prevail.

The auctioneer may advise email bidders if they have been outbid by another email bidder, but is not required to do so, so we suggest your first email bid indicate your highest level of interest for the lot.

Descriptions are provided by the individual lot sellers in the case of “member lots.”

Email bidders are welcome and encouraged to attend and participate in the live auction. If the winning bidder is not present at the live auction, he/she will be notified of the final selling price of the lot and shall be expected to arrange prompt payment for the lot plus shipping costs (which shall be by regular first class mail or such other level of shipping as the buyer may choose) directly with David Perry at davidlperryjr@gmail.com.

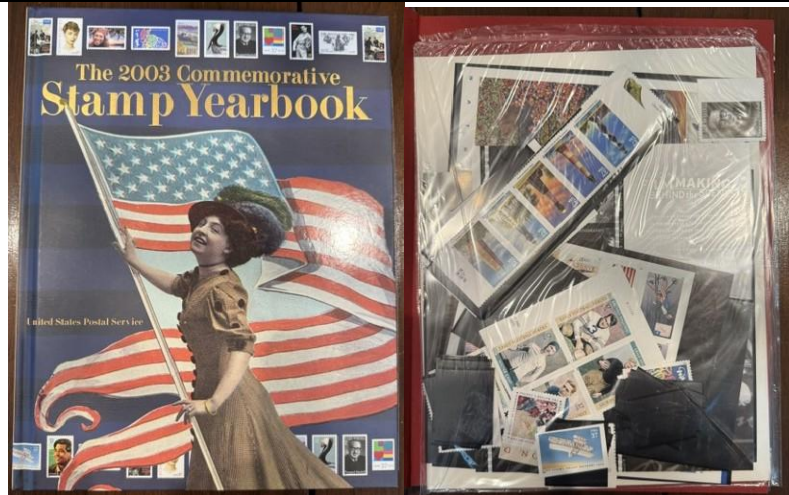
